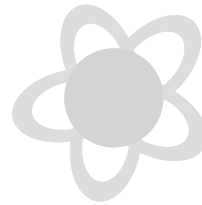


Because of their design versatility and excellent fit, the trousers DORTJE are a favorite among European seamstresses. DÖRTJE can be sewn with or without the horizontal seams, and with or without the elastic gathers on the side seams.

The trousers DORTJE are cut generously: Please be certain to take measurements, including the inseam. The trousers will hang approximately one inch shorter when the elastic gathers are incorporated.

Important: Please take measurements, especially the waist and the desired length.

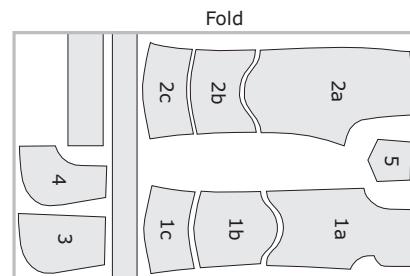

Cutting the Layout

Fold fabrics in half lengthwise so that one selvage lies on the other and the right side is facing in. Pin pattern pieces to left side of the fabrics as shown in the cutting layout and include a 3/8" seam allowance. The pieces are cut with the grain. **Please note that the pattern pieces do not include a seam allowance.**

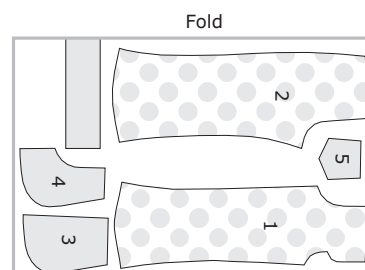
Pattern pieces / Cutting layout with cross seams

1a - Pants front top	2 x
1b - Pants front middle	2 x
1c - Pants front lower	2 x
2a - Pants back top	2 x
2b - Pants back middle	2 x
2c - Pants back lower	2 x
3 - Pocket	2 x
4 - Pocket bag	2 x
5 - Back pocket	2 x
Waistband (width 4")	1 x on fold
Bias tape (width 3")	1 x on fold



Pattern pieces / Cutting layout without cross seams

1 - Pants front	2 x
2 - Pants back	2 x
3 - Pocket	2 x
4 - Pocket bag	2 x
5 - Back pocket	2 x
Waistband (width 4")	1 x on fold



Sewing

1. Stitch approx. 5 inches of stretched elastic to the right side of each of the back middle pant leg piece at the seam allowance using a three-stitch zigzag stitch.
2. Stitch the front of the front pocket to the front upper pant leg right sides together. Trim seam allowance. Turn, press and topstitch. Pin back half of front pocket to the front piece and stitch along pocket bottom. Repeat for other side.
3. Stitch front upper, middle and front cuff pieces. Try not to stretch the fabric through the curves. Finish seam with 4-thread over edge or zigzag. Press upper seam upward, lower seam down and topstitch.
4. Press seam allowance on bottom and sides of back pockets inward. Stitch approx. 3/8 inch seam along bottom and sides of back pocket. Fold upper edge of back pockets twice, press and stitch at 3/8 inch. Topstitch close to edge of pocket tops. Pin and stitch pockets to upper back pant leg as indicated on the pattern sheet. Secure at corners with small zigzag stitches.
5. Stitch back pant leg upper, middle and cuff right sides together. Try not to stretch the fabric through the curves. Finish seams with 4-thread over edge or zigzag. Press upper seam upward, lower seam down and topstitch.
6. Stitch side seams right sides together. Begin at the cuff and be certain to stretch the elastic gathers on the back pant leg to match the middle piece of the front pant leg. Press seam and topstitch.
7. Press the cuff ruffle in half lengthwise. Pin to cuff, pleating the material every inch-and-a-half. Stitch to pant leg. Turn, press and topstitch.
8. Stitch the inseam. Press and topstitch.
9. Insert one pant leg right side out into the other pant leg right side in. Pin rise and stitch crotch seam.
10. Fold the fly inward and pin. Stitch around the fly and secure the bottom and top with small zigzag stitches. You may also insert a zipper into the fly as desired.
11. Stitch the waistband into a ring, leaving a small opening for the elastic. Stitch outside of waistband to right side of pants. Turn, press and topstitch. Insert elastic and close opening.
